## REGISTER



- Step 1: remember something from PT school
- Step 2: Check each school's testing policy
  - FSBPT allows "NPTE candidates" to take exam within 60 days of graduation
  - Not all schools allow this
  - Some schools require students to graduate then schedule to sit for exam
- Sign up
  - Apply for test with FSBPT.org
  - First fee is application
    - Students are not paying/signing up for exam yet
  - Additionally, students submit state licensure application form
    - Each state has different variation of this form
    - Go to state's website > find PT license application form > fill out > send to state

## PROCESS TO SIT



- Candidate submits credentials to the state
- State determines who is eligible to practice in their state
- If state determines candidate is eligible to sit for exam, state communicates directly to FSBPT
- FSBPT generates authorization to test letter and test number to NPTE candidate
  - This allows candidate to schedule an appointment to take test at a Prometric testing center
  - Test given in January, April, July, October

## FSBPT.org

- On main page, essential dates and deadlines on right column
- Need to have all registration done around 6 weeks before each test date

## COST

- Sign up for exam on FSBPT - \$485
- ~ \$100 at each state level
- \$85 fee at Prometric to sit



## PROMETRIC TESTING CENTER

- In larger metropolitan area, increased probability of open seat
- In mid/small town, probability decreases - may need to travel to a center
- Preference goes to candidates who sign up early
- Seats are limited
- Prometric will send candidates information on materials to bring (ID, etc.) in preparation for exam
- Plan your trip to center
